Stallion Season Auction set for January 30

The Thoroughbred Breeders' Association of New Jersey (TBANJ) will conduct its annual Stallion Season Auction beginning Tuesday, Jan. 30 and ending Thursday, Feb. 1.

The online auction is being hosted on the Wanamaker's bidding platform at www. wanamakers.com. All participants must be registered with Wanamaker's prior to bidding. Each season's conditions will be posted as part of their auction page on Wanamaker's. All proceeds from the auction go to the TBANJ, which uses the funds for promoting the Thoroughbred breeding industry in New Jersey. Stallion seasons will be added until the auction begins on Jan. 30 and a complete list of available seasons will be listed on www.njbreds.com.

2024 Thoroughbred racing dates conditionally approved

The New Jersey Racing Commission on Nov. 15 conditionally approved a 71-day racing schedule at Monmouth Park (May 11 to Sept. 15) and 20 dates at the Meadowlands (Oct. 4 to Dec. 7) for 2024.

The dates are conditional because the Meadowlands requested Standardbred racing dates on the same nights on Oct. 25 and 26,

Nov. 1, 2, 8, 9, 15, 16, 22, 23, 29, 30 and Dec. 6 and 7.

Additional information about the 2024 racing dates will be posted on the Thoroughbred Breeders' Association of New Jersey's website, www.njbreds.com, when it becomes available.
